




Build Season

- Video summaries published weekly
 - Safety Animation & Digital Animation submissions
- Even more use of CAD *before* fab & assy
 - Design interations before CNC cutting metal / Lexan
 - Improved in multi-user assemblies
- Swerve drive **v3.0!** complex drive system
- Investment in *re-usable* components
 - Most of Robot Hardware / Inventory budget is usable on future robots (e.g., RoboRio, Neo motors, controllers, gears, pneumatics)
 - Invested in Tools / Safety / Shop organization
- Building **TWO** robots
 - Test out design concepts on "practice" robot
 - Refine for "competition" robot
